Prior to the meeting, we are providing resources for your review, including a comprehensive <u>question-and-answer document</u>, including the final recommendation of the superintendent. The ad-hoc Feasibility Committees believes that, after careful study, an organizational plan that will best educate our children and also serve our taxpayers is being proposed.
